Three years ago the kick-off meeting of INTER-Regio-Rail has taken place. During this meeting the project partners, mostly passenger rail authorities from four countries of Central Europe have met and discussed in which way to implement their joint pilot projects, to organise the exchange of their experiences and to find joint positions.

Now, three years later, the project is coming to its end, leaving a track of changes all over Europe: In eight regions of Europe the partners have developed new tools to improve regional transport and tested them by implementing pilot projects, making sure these are transferrable to other countries and regions.
